



CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARS

These notes are intended to outline the conditions for scholars who have been offered a UEL Scholarship. Such scholars must be on a tier 4 general student visa.

The University at its sole discretion reserves the right to allocate and administer the scholarship award as appropriate and conditions may be subject to change.

The Award

The scholar is expected to enrol for the intake stated on their Scholarship Offer Letter. In exceptional circumstances the University will consider one deferral to the next intake and this will need to be agreed by the Director of International Office who will consult with colleagues as appropriate. Please note that deferral is not possible if a student visa have been granted.

The scholar must comply with the terms and conditions of admittance and the University's Regulations, including our Attendance Policy. Where there is a failure to comply then the scholarship award may be withdrawn in whole or part

The scholar will be expected to complete their programme of study successfully within the time frame outlined on their Scholarship Offer Letter. The scholarship award does not cover additional costs for any re-takes of module/s.

If the award covers accommodation as part of the scholarship, this will be a single occupancy room in our on-campus halls of residence. It will be the scholar's responsibility to accept the room offer within the specified time frame. The award will not cover any alternative accommodation and no payment in lieu will be made where the on-campus single occupancy room is not occupied. Scholars who are accompanied by dependants will not be able to live on campus and will need to make their own accommodation arrangements and meet the associated costs.

Scholarships do not include any other expenses, for example living and transport costs, unless these are specifically detailed in the offer letter.

The scholar will be expected to participate in current and future promotional activities and as such will be interviewed and photographed by our marketing department. The scholar will also contribute from time to time to the promotion of UEL by supporting events organised for scholars and events organised by the International Office. The scholar agrees no payment will be made by the University to the scholar for their participation in promotional activities. The scholar assigns to the University any intellectual property or other rights which are created as part of the promotional material.

International Sports Scholarships

Successful undergraduate applicants will need to reapply for the award for each year of their studies. Continuation of the award is subject to you maintaining or exceeding your current level of sporting performance. The International Sports Scholarships are also subject to



acceptance of the terms of the scholarship which include representing University of East London at all relevant British University (BUCS) competitions, completing 10 hours of ambassadorial duties (e.g. school visits, open days, media events), and committing to maximising your potential in sport.

Tier 4 (General) Student Visa

All scholars will be required to apply for prior appropriate student entry clearance (Tier 4 General Student). Student immigration requirements for entry into the UK are operated on a points based system. Scholars must ensure that they meet all the requirements for entry within their application, in line with the UK Border Agency's Tier 4 Policy Guidance. Scholars will need to be aware of what their scholarship award covers as they will be responsible for meeting any additional costs towards their tuition fees and/or living expenses and providing the relevant evidence with their visa application. Scholars should only proceed with their acceptance of the award if they are confident that they meet these requirements. The scholarship award will not be made, or if made will be withdrawn where a Tier 4 student visa is not granted, or is subsequently withdrawn

If the scholar wishes his/her dependants to accompany him/her during their studies at UEL please note they will be responsible for meeting the requirements for a dependant's visa.
